Comprehension	The student has difficulty demonstrating comprehension and is unable to answer basic questions related to the text.	The student demonstrates general comprehension of the text and successfully answers a few questions.	The student is able to demonstrate comprehension and successfully answers most of the basic and higher order questions.	The student comprehends and answers all questions and completes all related tasks with detailed answers and explanations.
Reacting to reading	The student is unable to share his or her reaction to the text.	The student has difficulty sharing what he or she thinks about the text.	The student shares his or her reaction to the text and makes a connection to the text.	The student shares what he or she thinks about the text and also makes detailed connections to the text.

Please note : Level 1 (it should be verified that although the student's oral communication is at a B level, he or she may be reading at the Voie A level. If so, adjustments should be made to support learning to read at the A level as he or she transitions to Voie B in reading.)
